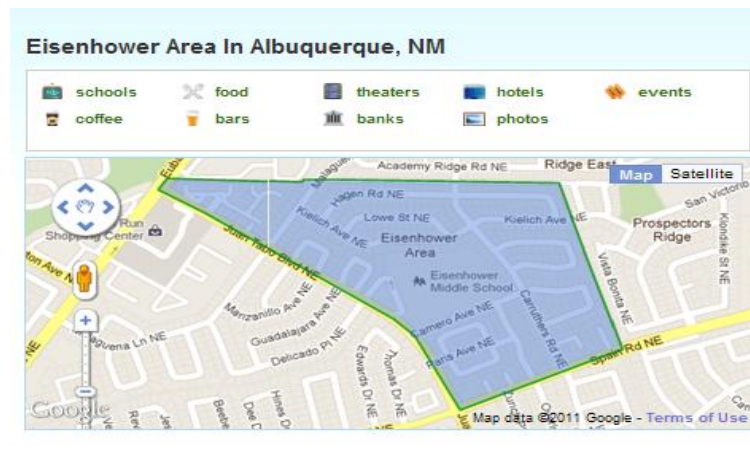
A call for Block Watch Partners.

A series of windows were shot at with a BB gun on Carruthers. A police report was filed. A \$50 reward is being offered to anyone who can provide information leading to the apprehension or arrest of the person who shot front window of home on Carruthers late night 9/25 or early 9/26. Contact 237-2739 if you have any information on this unfortunate incident.

Some traffic improvement projects have already been completed with coordination between EANA and the city. Improvements have been made particularly around the Eisenhower Middle school (double yellow centerline on Camero between Carruthers and Juan Tabo and yellow painted curbs for no parking at the intersection of Camero and Overlook. It was also recommended to enhance the EANA entrances at Spain and Carruthers and Malaguena and Juan Tabo and proposals include possible striped bulb-outs at these intersections. This is still in review and homeowners at these locations will be notified by the City as to their opinions on this.

Bylaws Amendment
